FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS MEMBERSHIP

What is the minimum and maximum number of members?

The membership must be between 5 and 19 members, as set out in the school's Constitution in line with the Education Act and Regulations. This must include at least 3 Parent Members, 1 Teacher Member, and the Principal.



What is the make-up of the membership?

The composition is defined in the school's Constitution, in line with the Education Act and Regulations.

Who decides the make-up and total number?

Members determine the total number and composition within the 5 to 19 range, in line with the Education Act and Regulations.

What are the membership types?

Parent Member, Teacher Member, Principal, Student Member, Invited Member

How many Parent Members must there be?

A minimum of 50% of the total membership must be parents of students enrolled at the school. The number of parent members is defined in the school's Constitution.

How many Teacher Members must there be?

At least 1 teacher member (other than the Principal). The number is defined in the school's Constitution.

Is the Principal always a member?

Yes.

Can we have student members?

Yes

Only if the school provides secondary education and this is included in the Constitution. The number is defined in the school's Constitution.

Can we invite people from the community to be members?

Yes.

If included in the Constitution.

The number is defined in the school's Constitution.

Can the Constitution be amended?

Yes.

It should be reviewed annually and may be amended in line with Department policy and guidelines using the model template.
